Recap of 2014-2015 and our Vision for the coming year.

As defined in our Articles of incorporation Iron Aid Foundation was setup with specific community oriented goals. These goals are core to our belief of providing education to Muslims in the area and to promote good citizenship with the muslim community as well as driving engagement with the wider non-muslim community.

During the last year we have continued to look for suitable properties in the Northwood/Pinner area in order to establish a base from where we could provide a centre for education, promote social inclusion and drive engagement with the surrounding non-muslim community . In order to be viable there has to be ample parking, a D1 usage (which allows for community uses and places of worship etc) and 24/7 access. Houses and shop fronts are not suitable as we would quickly outgrow these.

Our Achievements in the past year

We have been very active in the past year in increasing the services we provide to the community and in our Worship services. We have initiated:

Morning (pre dawn) prayers. This is an important prayer time for all Muslims and we are pleased to offer this additional congregational prayer along with evening prayers and Friday prayers

Mens fitness class – this is held on Wednesdays and is very well attended. Iron Aid feel that we have a responsibility to promote good health within our community.

Weekly Friday Class – This class is focused on understanding the Quran. Specific passages are discussed and their meanings explained. The class is well attended.

Inter Faith Community Cohesion Summer Charity Fete for the Paul Strickland Scanner Centre. This event was held on X and arranged in partnership with the St Johns Church and raised X

We are very excited about the prospects for the coming year. Iron Aid Foundation is now an established institution in the area and we have started the important work of engaging with the local community both Muslim and non-Muslim.
