

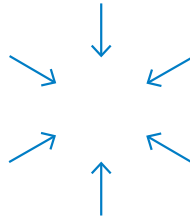

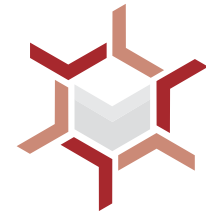
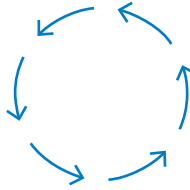
1.

Centre of unity, coming together.
Single common goal.
Central focus, strong bonds.



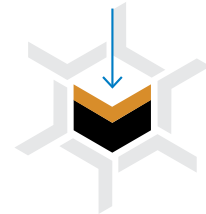
2.

Circular arrow motion.
Working together, integration.
Hints at *tawaaf*— anti-clockwise motion around the Kaabah.
Commitment and co-operation.

Downward arrow motion.
Emphasis on 'sending down' iron and revelation.
In Quran 57:25 iron was 'sent down.' Also the coming down of revelation and divine guidance.

A cube of solidarity representing the Kaabah as the universal symbol of unity. The top profile of the cube has been left incomplete for open interpretation of meaning. Some would see the Kaabah while others may just see the downward arrow representing revelation and the coming down of iron as mentioned above.

The shape could be seen as a gesture of power, strength, a spark of energy and generating goodness.



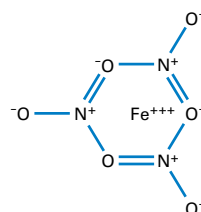

The symbol carries the general style of a classical geometric Islamic pattern.

The symbol resembles chemical diagrams of iron-based compounds studied and explored by scientists, e.g. this chemical diagram of Ferric Nitrate. It may be seen as a deep-rooted visual symbol of strength in the chemical bonds of iron.
